PART 1

Why Christians Look Up

God made the sky to speak

"Let them serve as signs to mark sacred times, and days and years." (Genesis 1:14)

"The heavens declare the glory of God." (Psalm 19:1)

He named the constellations

"He is the Maker of the Bear and Orion, the Pleiades." (Job 9:9)

"Can you bring forth the constellations in their seasons?" (Job 38:32)

Stargazers found Jesus

"We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him." (Matthew 2:2)

The Magi read the sky, and it led them straight to Christ. That's the heart of this guide: let the stars point you to the One who made them.

PART 2

How We Blend the Two

Think of astrology as a language of themes and Scripture as the voice of truth. Each day, we let the sky start the conversation and let God's Word finish it.

1. Read the sky

Look up and notice the season you're in. Every sign, moon phase, and retrograde carries a theme, from balance in Libra season to letting go as the moon wanes

2. Find the Scripture

Look for what the Bible says about that same theme. Libra season talks about balance; Micah 6:8 shows us God's balance.

3. Reflect and pray

Ask what God might be stirring in you through this season, then bring it to Him in prayer.

Our anchors

- Scripture has the final word
- The stars reflect God's glory; God holds your future
- Your chart describes you; Christ defines you

Your Big Three

Your birth chart shows where the Sun, Moon, and rising sign were when you were born.

Find yours free at astro-charts.com or any astrology app.

Sun sign: your core self

Astrology lens: The Sun describes your basic nature and purpose.

Faith lens: who God created you to be (Psalm 139:14).

Moon sign: your inner world

Astrology lens: The Moon describes your emotions and what makes you feel safe.

Faith lens: where you need God's comfort (Isaiah 66:13).

Rising sign: how you meet the world

Astrology Lens: our rising sign describes first impressions and outward style.

Faith lens: how you reflect Christ to others (Matthew 5:16).

Gift: Courage to go first. Growth: Patience and humility.

"Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

(Joshua 1:9)

Prayer: Lord, let my boldness follow Your lead.

Taurus • The Bull • Earth

Apr 20 – May 20

Steady, loyal, loves beauty and comfort

Gift: Faithfulness. Growth: Trusting God beyond security.

"Look at the birds of the air... your heavenly Father feeds them." (Matthew 6:26)

Prayer: Be my security when comfort runs out.

Gemini & Cancer

Gemini • The Twins • Air

May 21 – Jun 20

Curious, quick, a gifted communicator

Gift: Words that connect. Growth: Listening and focus.

"Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry." (James 1:19)

Prayer: Guard my words and slow my mind.

Cancer • The Crab • Water

Jun 21 – Jul 22

Nurturing, protective, deeply feeling

Gift: Making others feel at home. Growth: Finding home in God.

"Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations." (Psalm 90:1)

Prayer: Be my home when I feel unsafe.

Leo & Virgo

Leo • The Lion • Fire

Jul 23 – Aug 22

Warm, confident, generous, magnetic

Gift: Lighting up a room. Growth: Pointing the spotlight to God.

"Not to us, Lord, not to us but to your name be the glory." (Psalm 115:1)

Prayer: Let my light point back to You.

Virgo • The Maiden • Earth

Aug 23 – Sep 22

Thoughtful, precise, devoted to service

Gift: Faithful attention to detail. Growth: Receiving grace over perfection.

"My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." (2 Corinthians 12:9)

Prayer: Free me from needing to be perfect.

Libra & Scorpio

Libra • The Scales • Air

Sep 23 – Oct 22

Fair, gracious, relationship-minded

Gift: Peacemaking. Growth: Choosing truth over keeping peace.

"Act justly and love mercy and walk humbly with your God." (Micah 6:8)

Prayer: Teach me Your kind of balance.

Scorpio • The Scorpion • Water

Oct 23 – Nov 21

Intense, loyal, drawn to depth

Gift: Seeing beneath the surface. Growth: Trusting and letting go.

"If anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come." (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Prayer: Transform what I'm afraid to show You.

Sagittarius & Capricorn

Nov 22 – Dec 21

Adventurous, honest, a seeker of truth

Gift: Hunger for meaning. Growth: Commitment and follow-through.

"You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:13)

Prayer: Let every search lead me to You.

Capricorn • The Sea-Goat • Earth

Dec 22 – Jan 19

Disciplined, responsible, ambitious

Gift: Building what lasts. Growth: Rest and receiving.

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28)

Prayer: Teach me to rest in what You've built.

Aquarius & Pisces

Aquarius • The Water Bearer • Air

Jan 20 – Feb 18

Visionary, independent, community-minded

Gift: Imagining a better world. Growth: Closeness and vulnerability.

"Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds."

(Hebrews 10:24–25)

Prayer: Draw me into real community.

Pisces • The Fish • Water

Feb 19 – Mar 20

Compassionate, intuitive, spiritual

Gift: Deep empathy. Growth: Boundaries and grounding.

"The Spirit helps us in our weakness." (Romans 8:26)

Prayer: Anchor my tender heart in You.

PART 5

The Planets & Scripture

Sun: Identity, purpose

"The sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its rays." (Malachi 4:2)

Moon: Emotions, inner life

"He made the moon to mark the seasons." (Psalm 104:19)

Mercury: Communication, thinking

*"May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight."
(Psalm 19:14)*

Venus: Love, beauty, relationships

"Love is patient, love is kind." (1 Corinthians 13:4)

Mars: Drive, courage, conflict

"Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power." (Ephesians 6:10)

Jupiter: Growth, blessing, expansion

"Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine." (Ephesians 3:20)

Saturn: Discipline, time, lessons

"He has made everything beautiful in its time." (Ecclesiastes 3:11)

Uranus: Change, the unexpected

"See, I am doing a new thing!" (Isaiah 43:19)

Neptune: Dreams, faith, the unseen

"Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." (Hebrews 11:1)

Pluto: Transformation, rebirth

"I am the resurrection and the life." (John 11:25)

Moon Phases

New Moon: fresh starts

Astrology: set intentions. Faith: write them as prayers.

"His compassions never fail. They are new every morning." (Lamentations 3:22–23)

First Quarter: take action

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." (Psalm 119:105)

Full Moon: harvest and clarity

Astrology: what you planted comes to light. Faith: give thanks for what God has grown.

"Established forever like the moon, the faithful witness in the sky." (Psalm 89:37)

Last Quarter: release

"Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you." (1 Peter 5:7)

Retrogrades & Eclipses

When a planet looks like it's moving backward, astrologers call it retrograde, a season to slow down and revisit its theme.

Mercury retrograde: words and plans

"In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps."

(Proverbs 16:9)

Venus retrograde: love and the past

"Forget the former things... See, I am doing a new thing!" (Isaiah 43:18–19)

Mars retrograde: anger and drive

"In your anger do not sin." (Ephesians 4:26)

Saturn retrograde: timing and lessons

"There is a time for everything." (Ecclesiastes 3:1)

Eclipses: turning points

"The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood..." (Joel 2:31). Even when the lights shift, God does not.

1. Which of my Big Three feels most like me? Which verse speaks to it?

2. What gift does my sun sign point to, and how can I use it for God?

3. What growth area does my sign name? Where is God inviting me to grow?

4. What season is the sky in right now, and what might God be saying through it?
